Mayor Atchley chaired the meeting with Lynn K. McClurg as secretary of the meeting. A motion was made by Alderman Ownby and seconded by Alderman Carr to approve the minutes of the April 20, 2009 meeting and to dispense with the reading. Motion carried.

PUBLIC FORUM

Mayor Atchley opened the public forum section of the meeting. Atchley recognized Charles Cunningham and Jeanette Jenkins, each of whom expressed concerns regard parking and sanitation conditions of the thrift store on SR66 at Longview Drive. Steve Hendrix stated that staff is already investigating the concerns. Atchley recognized Mrs. Burnside, who expressed concerns regarding grading along the river at the Blalock concrete plant on Boyds Creek Road. Atchley recognized Randy Corlew with Wilbur Smith Associates, engineer for the grading project, who described the project plans and state oversight. There being no further comments, the public forum was closed.

A motion was made by Alderman Ownby and seconded by Alderman Loveday to reschedule the June 15, 2009 meeting to June 22, 2009. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Mayor Atchley presented and placed for passage an Ordinance O2009-009 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY AND TO INCORPORATE SAME WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF SEVIERVILLE, TENNESSEE, A PORTION OF COLLIER DRIVE, PROPERTY LYING ALONG COLLIER DRIVE, AND A PORTION OF RIDGE ROAD." A motion was made by Alderman Gibbs and seconded by Alderman Loveday to approve the ordinance as presented and to dispense with the reading. Those voting Yes: Carr, Gibbs, Loveday, McCroskey, Ownby. Those voting No: None. Atchley declared the ordinance passed on second reading.

Mayor Atchley presented and placed for passage an Ordinance O2009-010 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF SEVIERVILLE, TENNESSEE, AS SET FORTH IN THE SEVIERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, § 14-201, TO PLACE THE C-3 INTERMEDIATE COMMERCIAL ZONING DESIGNATION UPON PROPERTY ON COLLIER DRIVE AND A PORTION OF THE RIGHT OF WAY OF COLLIER DRIVE AND RIDGE ROAD, AND, TO PLACE THE A-R AGRICULTURE-RESIDENTIAL ZONING DESIGNATION UPON PROPERTY ON COLLIER DRIVE AND A PORTION OF THE RIGHT OF WAY ON COLLIER DRIVE (PROPERTIES INCLUDED IN ANNEXATION ORDINANCE O2009-009)." A motion was made by Alderman Gibbs and seconded by Alderman Loveday to approve the ordinance as presented and to dispense with the reading. Those voting Yes: Carr, Gibbs, Loveday, McCroskey, Ownby. Those voting No: None. Atchley declared the ordinance passed on second reading.

Mayor Atchley presented and placed for passage an Ordinance O2009-011 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE AND ABANDON THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF AN UNOPENED PORTION OF AIRPORT ROAD." A motion was made by Alderman Carr and seconded by Alderman Ownby to approve the ordinance as presented and to dispense with the reading. Those voting Yes: Carr, Gibbs, Loveday, McCroskey, Ownby. Those voting No: None. Atchley declared the ordinance passed on second reading.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Atchley recognized Don Myers, who requested permission to apply for Governor's Highway Safety grants to purchase traffic safety related equipment and program management in amounts of \$4,996.00 and \$19,470.00 respectively. A motion was made by Alderman Ownby and seconded by Vice-Mayor McCroskey to approve the grant applications as requested. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Don Myers, who requested permission to close Court Avenue from Commerce Street to Bruce Street from 10:30 AM to 12:00 PM on Memorial Day, Monday May 25th. A motion was made by Alderman Loveday and seconded by Alderman Gibbs to approve the street closures as requested. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Lynn McClurg, who requested approval of a contract with the University of Tennessee to fund the salary and benefits of the hybrid trolley technician for the period of January 1, 2009 through April 30, 2009. McClurg explained that the contract (TN-26-7021) replaces a portion of the contract (TN-26-7034) approved on December 18 2006 and is necessary due to a transfer of FTA grant funds. A motion was made by Alderman Carr and seconded by Alderman Ownby to approve the contract as requested. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Lynn McClurg, who requested approval and/or ratification of the following expense(s) in excess of \$5,000.00 and contingency expenses:
