Steve Hendrix reported that lighting along the Parkway is in the design phase to account for a water-main location, and should be bid in the spring. Alderman McCroskey requested an update on the

Paine Lake Estates greenway project. Hendrix reported that plans have been approved by the State and that the City is in the process of acquiring rights-of-way.
