Mayor Atchley recognized Steve Hendrix, who presented monthly staff reports.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Mayor Atchley presented and placed for passage an Ordinance O2009-025 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF SEVIERVILLE, TENNESSEE, AS SET FORTH IN THE SEVIERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, § 14-201, TO REZONE PROPERTY ON THE NORTHERN SIDE OF POOL STREET NEAR BELLE MEADOWS FROM R-1 LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO R-2 MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT." A motion was made by Alderman Ownby and seconded by Alderman McCroskey to approve the ordinance as presented and to dispense with the reading. Those voting Yes: Carr, Gibbs, Loveday, McCroskey, Ownby. Those voting No: None. Atchley declared the ordinance passed on first reading.

Mayor Atchley presented a Resolution R2009-016 Authorizing the Novation of Interest Rate Swap Agreements Heretofore Entered into by the Public Building Authority of Blount County, Tennessee, the Public Building Authority of Sevier County, Tennessee, and the Public Building Authority of the City of Sevierville, Tennessee, for the Benefit of the City of Sevierville, Tennessee and Authorizing the Execution and Delivery of Documents Relating to Such Novated Swap Agreements. A motion was made by Alderman Loveday and seconded by Alderman Gibbs to approve the resolution as presented and to dispense with the reading. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Bryon Fortner, who presented bids for a knuckle boom brush truck and recommended acceptance of the low qualified bid and award contract to Stringfellow, Inc. in the amount of \$104,710.00 for a Freightliner M2 106 equipped with a PacMac KBF20H body. A motion was made by Vice-Mayor Carr and seconded by Alderman Ownby to accept the bid and award the contract as recommended. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Don Myers, who presented a request on behalf of Mary John Tino for permission to close a portion of Old Douglas Dam Road on Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup> for Carriage Rides. A motion was made by Alderman McCroskey and seconded by Alderman Loveday to approve the street closure as requested. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Don Myers, who requested permission to close portions of Honey Lane, Forks of the River Parkway, Main Street and Court Avenue on Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup> for the Christmas Parade. A motion was made by Alderman Ownby and seconded by Vice-Mayor Carr to approve the street closures as requested. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Lynn McClurg, who requested approval and/or ratification of the following expense(s) in excess of \$5,000.00:
