

Following is a status report of ongoing and planned road projects within the City of Sevierville as of July 17, 2009.

SR 66 from SR 338 (Boyd's Creek Hwy.) to SR 448 (North Parkway) Expansion: This TDOT project has been awarded to contractor Blalock and Sons. Construction has begun. Project length is estimated at 30 months. The expansion will widen Hwy. 66 from four to six lanes from Boyd's Creek Hwy. to the new Hwy. 448.

Old Knoxville Hwy.: The north section (between Eagles Landing Golf Club and just north of Reed Schoolhouse Road) and south (Between Gists Creek Road and Main Street) sections will be completed in phases, but traffic will be maintained during construction. No estimated construction start date at this time.

SR 449/Veteran's Blvd. Northern Extension: This is included in the City's Central Business Improvement District project. The new road will connect SR 449/Veteran's Blvd. at Dolly Parton Parkway to Hwy. 66 and provide another bridge over the Little Pigeon River. This project will likely be constructed in phases, with the first phase being the section from Dolly Parton Pkwy to Robert Henderson Rd. No estimated construction start date at this time.

SR 66 From I-40 to SR 338 (Boyd's Creek Hwy.) Expansion: This TDOT project may be completed in two phases: I-40 to SR 149; and SR 149 to SR 338. The phase from I-40 to SR 149 is scheduled to be bid in March 2010. The expansion would increase Hwy. 66 from four to six lanes, from I-40 to Boyd's Creek Hwy.
