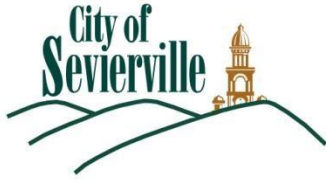

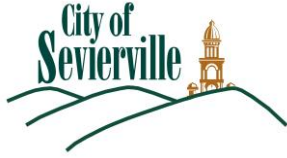

OLD BUSINESS

HEARING – MR. & MRS. THOMAS JOHNS, SR REQUEST A HEARING REGARDING A NOTICE OF VIOLATION – 503 FRED SALES PLACE (CITY).

Mr. Smith provided staff's recommendation to table the item indefinitely. Mr. Black added that great progress had been made on the clean up of this site.
