- ♦ We continue to follow TENNESSEE PLEDGE guidance for operation of all of our facilities.
- ◆ Staff has figured out a method to have an abbreviated Summer Camp beginning July 13.
- ♦ John Sevier Memorial Grove is about 95% completed-plaques will be installed prior to the dedication in October.
- ♦ We had our first Youth Weekend Tournament on June 20 and 21 following all of the TENNESSEE PLEDGE guidelines.
- ◆ We opened the Family Aquatics Center on June 18th following the TENNESSEE PLEDGE quidelines.
- ◆ Progress is being made on the West Prong Greenway construction.

Fiscal Year 2020 Goals and Projects Status Report

Parks and Recreation 44410 (Department Administration/Outdoor Parks/Greenways)

- ◆ Administer the Recreation Trails Grant funds to complete West Prong Greenway extension and improvements. Project is 95% complete as of June 30, 2020-Extension of Contract was necessary due to challenges with location of the Observation Deck because of a 24" gas line. Completion expected by July 30, 2020.
- ♦ Continue to upgrade to LED lights in P&R on greenway trails. Funds were diverted to West Prong Greenway Project, thus no work was completed in FY 2020.
- Complete Phase III Greenway Project and Complex to Boys and Girls Club on Middle Creek Greenway. Project completed in April 2020.
- ♦ Grant submitted for Phase I re-development of JB Waters Park, which is a dog park. Grant was submitted, however it was not approved for funding.
- Grant submitted for Technical Assistance with Greenway Development; if approved move forward with Blueway Planning efforts.
 Grant was submitted; it was not approved. However, NPS highly suggests reapplying in 2021. Blueway Planning continues by staff along with Feds and State.
- ♦ Complete Parks and Recreation Foundation legal requirements, attend Foundation Training and have the Foundation operational by early Calendar Year 2020. Foundation legal requirements were completed; Foundation was appointed and began organization in February 2020. Director attended Foundation Training November 2020.
- Support streetscapes landscaping efforts as needed. Funding moved to FY 2021 due to delays.
- ♦ Support City Wayfinding Program efforts as needed. Assisted in development of Municipal Complex Wayfinding; to be completed in FY 2021.
- Research combining playgrounds from McMahan Addition and behind Community Center into one improved playground area.
 Funds diverted to West Prong Greenway Project-No work for FY 2020.
- ♦ Complete proposed John Sevier Grove on Middle Creek upon Greenway Construction completion. Project 98% completed on June 30th; Ribbon Cutting delayed until October 2020 due to Pandemic concerns.
- ♦ Citizen Advisory Boards Combined: Recreation Advisory Board and Tree Board combined into one "Parks and Recreation Services Advisory Board."


Fiscal Year 2020 Goals and Projects Status Report

- Complete Roof Overlay Project on time and under budget. Project completed April 2020.
- Complete upgrades and repairs to PoolPac Unit which controls air and water quality in Natatorium. Project completed in March 2020.
- Review current Employee Wellness Program criteria. Review should include reducing absenteeism, boosting worker productivity and increasing retention. No activity in FY 2020.
- Parks and Recreation Master plan monitoring and implementation of recommendations as initiated or directed. Prices were obtained from contractor on Community Center Expansion as per the Master Plan.
- Implement Comprehensive Fees and Charges Policy and Cost Recovery Plan of Action. Plan Completed.




- Implement Comprehensive Fees and Charges Policy and Cost Recovery Plan of Action. Plan Complete.

May/June 2019 vs May/June 2020 Revenues and Attendance


Pre and Post COVID-19 Comparisons






May/June 2019 vs May/June 2020 Revenues and Attendance




