This public art proposal is a Sevierville Chamber of Commerce and Sevierville Commons Association joint project. The bronze statue of Dr. Massey’s birddog will be life-sized and set on a native limestone rock. Mr. Smith briefly explained the story of the Dr. Massey and his birddog, and the historical connection to the downtown district.
