

Open Top Roll-Off Guidelines

Effective 7/1/22

Roll-offs are available for rental to residential customers located inside the City Limits of Sevierville. Rental periods run for 30 consecutive days. If the roll-off is not emptied within the 30-day period, it will be picked up and the customer will be charged for the landfill tipping fee along with a \$150.00 haul fee. The roll-off will not be returned unless the customer has notified the Public Works Department of their wish to have the container returned.

These items CAN be loaded into a Roll-Off Container:

- * Wood
- * Sheetrock and paneling
- * Paper, cardboard
- * Ceramic tile, tubs, and sinks
- * Siding

- * Doors and Windows
- * Insulation (Non-Asbestos)
- * Carpet
- * Furniture
- * Wiring

These items <u>CANNOT</u> be loaded into a Roll-Off Container:

(If there is any of these materials then you will be charged a penalty fee.)

- * Electronics (TV's, Computers, Video Games, Satellite/Cable Receivers)
- * Furnaces, water heaters, or air conditioners
- * Leaves, grass, or brush/tree limbs (Exception with prior authorization from City.)
- * Shingles (Exception with prior authorization from City.)
- * Appliances
- * Tires
- * Fuel Tanks
- * Fluorescent bulbs
- * Metal

- * Batteries
- * Fluids, fuel, oil, gas, wet paint
- * Fertilizers, pesticides, solvents
- * Dirt, sand, gravel, concrete

The roll-off container must NOT be:

- Loaded above sides of container. Shingles should be at least 12 inches below the top.
- Loaded with heavy items that overload the container so that it cannot be lifted If this happens the customer will be responsible for unloading the material.
